- Residents are paid 75% of a comparable PT's wage and are a full-time employee. This allows us to ensure a successful applicant's existing experience is reflected in their offer.
- Residents see 75% of a full-time clinician's schedule with time set aside for Residency education and other tasks.
- Our residents are an employee of Providence, and as a result they have access to all of the regular benefits afforded to any employee. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Paid vacation and sick time
 - All mandated leave
 - Medical, Dental, Vision, Life insurances
 - Contribution to retirement accounts
 - Coverage under Providence's malpractice insurance
 - Access to a comprehensive Employee Wellness and Support program
 - Paid subscription to Medbridge including access to their continuing education library of courses.
- The only cost associated with the program is that we do require that our residents be a member of the APTA and the section associated with their field of study. We cover any additional curriculum expenses.
