<b>SUBJECT:</b> Resident Requirements for Receipt of a Certificate of Residency Completion

**I. PURPOSE/SCOPE**

In order to graduate from Providence Medical Group (PMG) St. Peter Family Medicine (SPFM) PGY2 ambulatory care residency a resident must comply with the standards outlined in this policy. Compliance with this policy will result in the resident being awarded a certificate of residency completion.

**II. POLICY & PROCEDURES**

- A. Meet Required ASHP Outcomes and Goals
  - 1. Receive “Achieved for Residency” for 100% of required objectives for PGY2 ambulatory care residency (Attachment A).
- B. Comply with PMG Policies
  - 1. Resident compliance to PMG polices as well as PMG SPFM Residency Program specific policies is determined by PRAC.
    - a. In order to successfully complete the residency program the resident may not have any outstanding Individualized Learning Plans (ILPs) or other unmet outcomes resulting from the Evaluation Policy process.
- C. Maintain responsibility for completion of the *minimum* required activities as listed in Attachment B – Table 1.
- D. Residents who fail to meet sections II A, B or C may be dismissed from the residency program as determined by the probation process outlined in the PGY2 Resident Evaluation Policy.
